**are invited to participate in JACO's  
20th Anniversary Exhibitions!**

As an artist who exhibited work in the Jung Association of Central Ohio Gallery between 1990 and 2009, you are eligible to show work in several venues especially reserved for this celebration.

**Two of the exhibits will be at the JACO Gallery, 59 West 3rd Avenue.**

**The first is in March and April, 2010.**

**The second is in September and October, 2010.**

**One exhibit will be at the High Road Gallery in Worthington,  
12 East Stafford Avenue (across from the Worthington Library),  
in September, 2010.**

Why three exhibits? Our space at the JungHaus can show about 25 pieces per show, and the High Road Gallery can show about 100. If many of the eligible artists want to show work, the JACO Gallery would be too limited, even with two exhibitions.

(Over 100 artists have shown work in one or more of the three JACO Gallery spaces over the almost 20 years. As many of these artists as possible will be contacted about the 2010 celebration of one of Columbus' unique galleries, where many artists have felt welcomed and supported.)

***This means each artist can exhibit work in one of the two JACO shows, and, in addition, show work at the High Road Gallery in September.***

***(Note: High Road Gallery schedules monthly shows; JACO Gallery has two-month long shows.)***

Example One: An artist has work in the March/April exhibit at the Jung Association Gallery, perhaps two or three pieces. In September, that artist exhibits work (same pieces, or different) at the High Road Gallery, maybe up to five pieces.

Example Two: An artist has work in the September/October exhibit at the JungHaus. In addition, that same artist could have other work (maybe up to five pieces) at the High Road Gallery.

**Since this is an anniversary year, the exhibits will have somewhat of a retrospective aspect. That means you could show work that has been in one of the previous JACO exhibits going back to 1990! Or new work is fine, as well. Either way, we need to have an idea of who wants to participate, and what you have that might be available to show. Both 3-D and 2-D works will be needed.**
