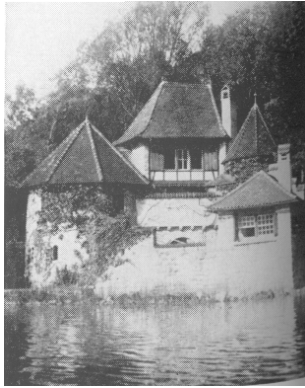

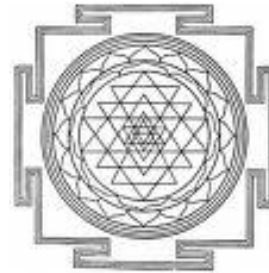

One of the key figures in modern depth psychology, Jung, initially a mentee of Sigmund Freud, developed theories that embraced myth, spirituality, and the imagination. His works have inspired many seeking to better navigate their own personal journey toward an increasingly whole and satisfying life.

Through lecture, guided discussion, and media presentation, participants will get a broad perspective on Jung's life and work.

Seminar participants will work with Murray Stein's excellent introductory book, *Jung's Map of the Soul*.
