Dr. Robert Moore is Distinguished Service Professor of Psychology, Psychoanalysis and Spirituality in the Graduate Center of the Chicago Theological Seminary. An internationally recognized psychoanalyst in private practice in Chicago, he has served as a Training Analyst at the C.G. Jung Institute of Chicago, and is Director of Research for the Institute for Integrative Psychotherapy and the Chicago Center for Integrative Psychotherapy. Author and editor of numerous books in psychology and spirituality, he lectures around the world on his formulation of a neo-Jungian approach to psychoanalysis. His most recent book is *Facing the Dragon: Confronting Personal and Spiritual Grandiosity.*

A Neo-Jungian Mapping Of the Psyche

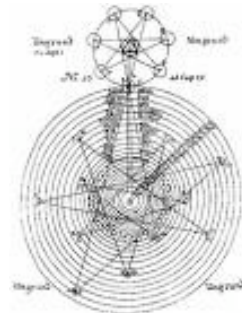
Jung’s work on the structure of the psyche, and especially the Collective Unconscious, was groundbreaking - but even Jung knew that it would continue to unfold.

In this lecture, analyst Robert Moore will introduce his discoveries about the deep structures of the Archetypal Self.

His “map of inner geography” will help us to better understand the role of the Self in balancing the opposites in our lives and the foundation of the transcendent function.

Moore’s Neo-Jungian mapping of the psyche will then focus on the implications of the organization of these deep structures for our psychological development and our spiritual growth toward wholeness.
